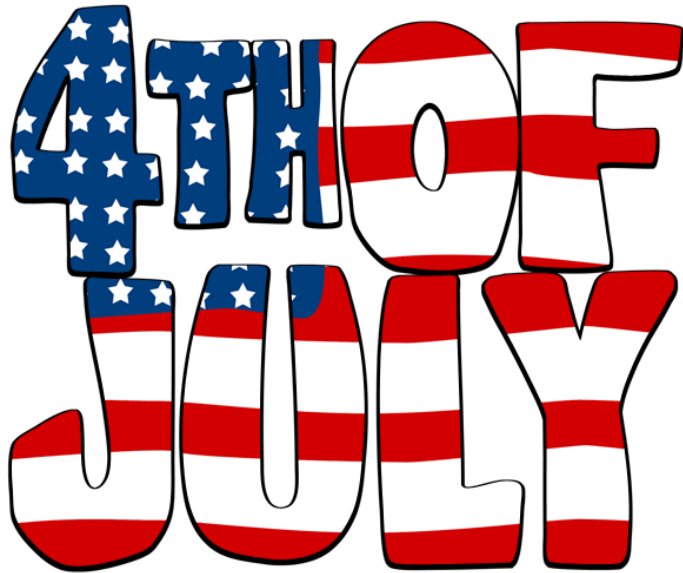

PARADE

PARADE RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Completed registration forms must be submitted via e-mail, fax, mail, or dropped off in person to the Monticello Village Hall NO LATER than 4PM on **Monday, July 2, 2012**.
2. No alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs may be consumed or displayed prior to or during the parade.
3. All floats must travel at a safe speed and be operated by an adult in possession of a valid driver's license. NO EXCEPTIONS.
4. During the parade line-up, please try to keep the noise level at a minimum so that volunteers can readily give instructions.
5. Floats must not be more than 14 feet high to allow clearance of traffic signals on Broadway.
6. All entries MUST be respectful and appropriate for a family environment.
7. All animals in the parade must be leashed, restrained or otherwise controlled in accordance with all applicable local ordinances.

Families, individuals, community groups, youth groups, businesses and civic organizations are invited to march in the parade to be held on **Wednesday, July 4, 2012**. Groups are encouraged to decorate floats and enter them in the parade to make the event as festive as possible! Owners of vintage cars are also invited to participate, and food vendors are welcome to set up at the parade end.

Line-up for the parade will start at 11AM at the parking lot across from the Government Center on North Street. The parade will step off at noon and will end at the corner of St. John Street and Broadway.
